## Inols

Hook Size H
Yarn Worsted/Aran Weight
preferrably Acrylic or Superwash to stand up to Outdoor Elements plus 5 colors of OmegaCryl. Sample used approx 260 yds
Loops \& Threads Impeccable in White and less than one ball each of OmegaCryl Sample Colors Mint (C1), Mexican Pink (C2), Citrus (C3), Jade (C4), and Coral (C5)

## Other Supplies

15.8 in White Foam Wreath Form
with a 6 in diameter
Clover 2 1/2 in Pom Pom Maker or make your own Yarn Needle

## fauge

18 dc will equal approximately 6 inches unstretched - there is wiggle room with this since you'll be stretching your work to fit around the wreath form.

## Aborerviations

ch - Chain
dc - Double Crochet
sts - Stitches
sl st - Slip Stitch
C1 - Color 1
C2 - Color 2
C3 - Color 3
C4 - Color 4
C5 - Color 5


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## Repeat Rom

Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn work, skip first dc, dc into the top of every dc until end. 18 dc worked including the turning ch3.

## Irreath Cover

Work the REPEAT ROW 7 times with White Yarn and C1.
Then work the REPEAT ROW 8 times each with White Yarn and Contrast Yarn in this color order: C2, C3, C4, C5, C3, C2, C1, and C5. You will have 9 different sections of colors of 8 repeats each. Your fabric should be roughly 6 " by $43^{\prime \prime}$ unstretched. If you don't have quite enough length, just add a couple more REPEAT ROWS until you do in the White Yarn and C5.


## Whipgititco: or Sip Stitch

Both the short ends together to form a ring. Then stretch to fit around the wreath form. Whipstitch or Slip Stitch the long sides together to completely cover the foam wreath. PINK LINES show whipstitch/slipstitch edges.


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## Finishing

Make 5 pom poms. 1 in each Contrast Color. Make 5 Tassels. 1 in each contrast color. Find a YouTube Tutorial on making the tassels here: https://youtu.be/xae_2QVKTCk Attach them to the bottom of the wreath in your preferred arrangement or use picture as a guide.
